**MPD(6, 1)** 1 Chichvarkina's Kutani Alexander. Smart, happy, pale gold and white, quite mature pup, an efficient mover, holding a good outline, masculine head with good strong teeth and width of jaw, well carried tail. 2 Cain's Kutani Skyfall. Litter brother to above, similar type and much the same remarks apply, fraction larger and lighter in eye. Two nice pups. 3 McKinnon's Polielin Pickapocket For Cherkhan.

**PD(4)** 1 Blake's Fengolas Simply Wonderful. Typy light gold with good mouth and jaw line, strong teeth with good head balance, kind, well shaped and coloured eye, held outline on the move, deep chest, well ribbed back. 2 McKinnon's Terendak Code Red Via Cherkhan. Busy soul, certainly alert, compact and balanced, easy mover, well bodied. 3 Hart's Anjesics Albany Of Khazedel.

**JD(4, 1)** 1 Quelch's Deelayne Pharara Ardquin. Thought very highly of this exhibit, strong contender in the challenge. Very rich gold and white, full of type, well balanced head, although markings distract a little, kind eye, arched neck, well made body, ribbed back and deep, free sound mover to and fro, lovely harsh textured coat, good for size and balance and has true expression. 2 Seward & Poole's Elleonia Rick O'Shay Tu Domensa. Masculine grey and whwhite, well bodied and good overall shape, not quite as free in front movement as first. 3 Scholes' Rossgilde Double Dream.

**YD(3)** 1 Young's Sinyul Al Pacino To Avonbourne. Not a big dog, but a lot of quality and type here in this grey and white boy, well balanced and shaped, good head properties, good bite, free and fluid mover, immature in coat as of yet, litter brother to BCC winner. 2 Scholes' Rossgilde Double Dream. Typy gold boy making a lovely outline and shape, well off for coat, moved easily, bit light in body condition at present. 3 Arnold's Raushanara Mr Fantasy.

**PGD(6, 1)** 1 Deveaux's Elleonia Stand N'stare At Pieldi JW. Nice size, well made all through, gold lad, well balanced head, necky, well placed shoulder and return of upper arm which help give him good profile movement. 2 Deacon's Andolyn Fly Me To The Moon. Good outline on this classy gold and white, good neck and topline, free mover, deep chest. 3 McKinnon's Polielin Aramis At Cherkhan JW ShCM.

**LD(8, 2)** Very mixed class. 1 Scarll & Sykes' Timazinti Danio. Two similar dogs headed this class. Both with a lot to offer, both typy and full of quality. Great outline and coat texture on this pale coloured dog which you really have to look at, masculine, well balanced head with good width of jaw, graceful neck into good shoulder, deep body, well ribbed back, covered ground easily and soundly, good tail carriage. Res CC. 2 Luscott's Jastina Trailblazer To Jalus ShCM. Well presented gold boy, again lovely outline, easy mover, deep body, lovely topline, slightly lighter eye than first. 3 Hall's Magic Prince Azurowa Amhara At Shenedene.

**OD(9)** 1 Waterhouse's Chtaura Well Did You Ever. Ideal size, solid grey, text book type for me, so well balanced all through, not the most glamorous but so much to offer, well made and balanced head showing good expression, good front and forechest, well laid shoulder, strong, correct ribcage and loin, jaunty, fluid, easy mover, sound to and fro, lovely tail carriage. CC and BOB. 2 Bell's Ch Vallena Almeida. Quality, compact black and white, showing well, arrogant expression on his typy head, well bodied and presented. 3 Lewis' Ch Deelayne Zaar Too Busy.

**MPB(6, 2)** 1 Andersson-Hamill's Tantra's Second Sight. Happy, classy 6 mth gold, pleasing all round, showing lots of promise, half sister to minor puppy dog winner. 2 Langford's Quaytown What A Wish. Well coated promising dark gold, shapely one of good size, easy mover, well bodied, preferred the head of first. 3 Walsh's Rossgilde Kaarina NATTAF.

**PB(4, 1)** 1 Bennett's Jalus Miranda. What a captivating puppy, rich gold with good attitude and true breed features, feminine head with good wide jaw, well formed body and well set tail, promising coat, smart mover. BP. 2 Roach's Anjesics Beaulieu. Young solid gold with good outline, feminine head with dark, well shaped eye, good body, not quite the freedom of movement of first. 3 Keegan's Ghiang's Savannah.

**JB(6, 2)** 1 Watts Catley's Zanamop's Truely Scrumious. Little star in the making here! Most promising, feminine, shapely, necky, well bodied and ribbed back, deep chest, easy stylish mover, dark, well shaped eye, good wide jaw. Res CC. 2 Richardson's Belazieth Smarties Red Gem. Deep red, well constructed and easy mover of good size, overshadowed by first. 3 Curtin's Chanceinn's Lady Penelope At Larlius.

**YB(6)** 1 McKinnon's Diamond Black Magic Among Cherkhan. Feminine tpyy particolour with typical head, well balanced and true expression, strong, wide jaw, adequate neck flowing into good shoulder and helping outline, motors around the ring. 2 Lloyd's Idaanns's Flaunt It For Hesidale. Taller black with good headpiece, kind, expressive eye and good bite, good tail carriage and good coat for age. 3 Curtin's Chanceinn's Lady Penelope At Larlius.

**PGB(8)** 1 Torrance's Sinyul Close Encounter. Solid grey of lovely size, maintaining her feminine outline with her easy flowing, sound movement, typical quality headpiece with strong jaw line and true expression, well made solid body, great coat texture, not too abundant, thought her quite a little gem, kept coming back to her in the challenge for her true breed type and balance. BCC. 2 Scarll & Sykes' Timazinti Liberty. Elegant gold and white with typical head proportions, well off for body, has good presence. 3 Waterhouse's Shingsa Total Eclipse With Chtaura.

**LB(13)** Difficult class. 1 Andersson-Hamill's Tantra's Mary Grace. Proud grey and white, typical headpiece, well made body and good topline, deep chest and well carried tail, maintains her strong outline with her free, arrogant, sound movement. 2 Pointon's Raushanara Over The Moon To Ballito. Mature, correct textured coat on this well presented, shapely bitch who had a good outline and level topline, good width to jaw, difficult decision between first and second. 3 Sutcliffe & Fleet's Fengolas Super Sassy At Newcliffe.

**OB(6)** 1 Roach's Anjesics Gypsy Rose. Attractive, shapely and with good outline and attitude, free moving, feminine head, nice for size and well made body, good tail set and carriage. 2 Bell's Vallena Adelia. Quality feminine particolour with easy flowing movement, very well presented, good type. 3 Waterhouse's Chtaura Everybody In Love.
